
## MOZART Project Brings Revolutionary Nano-Composite Coatings to the Automotive, Manufacturing, and Machining Industries

This tool incorporates optimization-based mathematical modeling and ontology theory to guide industrial end-users in selecting optimal coating types and various production parameters. These parameters include considerations like the type of current, its density, and the chemistry bath.

The DST from MOZART aims to empower end-users in implementing Safe and Sustainable technologies effectively. By aligning products, materials, and processes with the SSbD concept "by-Design," the tool supports industry players in making informed decisions that contribute to a more sustainable and environmentally conscious approach.
